No group or organization may use District property to unlawfully discriminate on the basis of race, color, ancestry, national origin, ethnic group identification, religion, age, gender, marital status, domestic partner status, sexual orientation, disability or AIDS/HIV status, medical conditions, genderidentity, or status as Vietnam Era veteran. These categories pecifically include status as lesbian, gay bisexual, transgender or questioning person or on any basis prohibited by law.		
Use of the District's civic centerswill be only for the purposes described by the California Legislature in Education Code Section 82537(a). These purposes include use by associations "formed for recreational, educational, political, economic, artistic, or moral
